

#### INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

Through this privacy policy, provided pursuant to Article 13 of EU Regulation 2016/679 (hereinafter also "GDPR"), a.Quantum S.p.A., (hereinafter also referred to as 'a.Quantum'), with registered office and headquarters in Rome, Piazzale Ostiense no. 2, 00154, certified email: a.quantum@pec.aceaspa.it, and contact email address: privacy@aceaspa.it, acting as Data Controller, aims to illustrate its privacy policy in order to outline how personal data (hereinafter "Data") voluntarily provided by visitors to the website <a href="www.a-quantum.it">www.a-quantum.it</a> (hereinafter "Website") are used when they request consultancy services and/or further information on the products in the water, electricity and environmental sectors marketed by A.Quantum.

The processing will take place in full compliance with the GDPR, the national adaption legislation referred to in Legislative Decree No. 196/2003 as amended by Legislative Decree No. 101/2018, as well as any other implementing legislation and any other applicable measures adopted by the Data Protection Authority (hereinafter collectively "**Privacy Legislation**").

#### 1. Data Controller

When processing personal data provided by visitors to the Website A.Quantum, with registered office at Piazzale Ostiense no. 2, 00154 – Rome, acts as the Data Controller. In order to offer the consultancy service expressly requested by Website visitors, a.Quantum may engage third parties who will act on its behalf as Data Processors on the basis of a contractual obligation in accordance with the provisions of Article 28 GDPR. Data may also be made available to individuals authorized to process the Data in accordance with current privacy law.

In any case, no Data will be disclosed.

# 2. Processed Data

A.Quantum will process the following categories of Data voluntarily provided by the Data Subjects while browsing the Website, as listed below:

- a) Personal data: first name, last name, VAT number in the case of single-member companies;
- b) Contact data: telephone number, email, city and postal code of residence.

# 3. Purposes and legal basis for processing

A.Quantum, acting as Data Controller, processes the Data voluntarily provided by visitors to the Website for the following purposes:

a.Quantum S.p.A.



- 1. closely related to the management of requests for information and/or assistance made by the data subjects themselves;
- 2. necessary for the management of any pre-contractual requests and/or the completion of the purchase by the data subjects of the products and/or services advertised by a.Quantum through the Website.

The provision of Data for the aforementioned purposes, connected with a pre-contractual and/or contractual phase or necessary for a request from the Data Subjects, is mandatory, and, otherwise, the Controller will be unable to process the requests made by the Data Subjects mentioned above, pursuant to Article 6, paragraph 1, letter b).

### 4. Retention of collected data

A.Quantum, acting as Data Controller, stores the Data collected in its systems in a form that allows the identification of the Data Subjects for a period of time strictly necessary for the purposes for which the data is processed, and in any case for a maximum period of 3 years.

### 5. Methods of processing

The processing of the Data is carried out through automated means (e.g., by using electronic procedures and media) and/or manually (e.g., on paper) for the time strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which the Data has been collected and, in any case, in compliance with the applicable legal provisions.

The Data Controller has adopted appropriate technical and organizational measures to ensure a level of security appropriate to the risk pursuant to Article 32 of the GDPR, in order to prevent Data loss, unlawful or improper use, as well as unauthorized access.

# 6. Transfer of data abroad

For the purposes described in this policy, A.Quantum does not transfer the Data provided to companies, entities, or international organizations established in countries outside the European Union.

### 7. Rights of the Data Subject

As a Data Subject, you will be able to exercise your rights under Articles 15 et seq., such as the right of access, right to erasure, right to rectification, right to object, and right to restriction of processing. In any case, you are always entitled to lodge a complaint with the Data Protection Authority.
