### **GESESA - Projects for Transversal Skills and Orientation - Agreement signed for the third consecutive year with the "G. Alberti" Higher Education Institute of Benevento.**

Benevento - 30/11/2023- A Memorandum of Understanding was signed between the "G. Alberti" Higher Education Institute of Benevento and GESESA, the company managing the integrated water service in the Sannio area. The project, which will be developed in the classroom, will explore industrial refinement methods for drinking water and wastewater treatment systems, with a focus on reuse for irrigation, civil, and industrial purposes.
