With the Acea Virtual Tour projects, thanks to the use of 3D headsets, visitors can enjoy an immersive experience exploring the Group's plants dedicated to recycling, plastic regeneration, and energy production from waste. A virtual journey that shows up close how waste is transformed into resources, promoting transparency, innovation, and environmental awareness.
